2019 FLU Event information



- What is the location and time of the event?
 - Date: Saturday, November 2, 2019
 - Time: Event will be open to the public from 10:00am to 4:00pm
 - Where: Freedom High School, 2500 West Taft Vineland Road, Orlando
 - How: Flu shots and Hep A vaccines will be given primarily using a drive through model with an optional indoor section.
- If it is an all-day (8+ hrs) event can staff work ½ day?
 - Staff will have the choice to either work a full day or half day. The shifts will be 9:00am to 1:00pm or 12:30pm to 4:30pm. Set-up and Breakdown team will have different start and end times. All leads will work 8:30am to 5:00pm.
- Will staff be given overtime or just flex-time that can be accrued since clinics are balancing leave requests during the next week and it will be difficult to cover the clinics with flex time owed with already approved leave?
 - Staff that work a 40-hour work week will get overtime for working the event if they go over their hours during that week.
 - Staff that work an 80-hour time period will receive comp time for working at the event if they go over the 80-work period.
 - Staff should be allowed to accrue the comp time and use it at a later date. It does not need to be used within that 2-week period. That will give them the flexibility to use the comp time during already pre-approved leave and not hurt the staffing of the clinics.
- What is the age group that we are focusing on?
 - Flu shot will be available for anyone 6 months or over.
 - Hep A will be available for anyone over the age of 19 years. No vaccines will be given to children.
- What vaccines will we be giving?
 - Only Flu and Hep A will be given out.
- Will they be in single dose syringes or multi dose vials?
 - All doses will be prefilled, single use syringes
- Will the form that is given to the client at intake address the allergies specific to these vaccines and illness specific to these vaccines?
 - Clients will be given the VIS form for both shots.
- Will the nurse be entering in Florida Shots? HMS?
 - Information will be entered into FLShots and HMS at a later date. They will be tied to the service provider. No data entry will be done onsite.
- Will there be cards with documentation to give the client? What is the follow up for the second dose of Hep A and instructions?
 - Anyone receiving the Hep A vaccine will get a card with information on how to follow up to receive their 2nd dose.
- Will there be written discharge instructions on what to expect from the vaccine and what to do if reaction occurs?
 - All the information will be on the VIS form.
